

## DATES OF INTEREST

- ♦ Fall, 1916 -- First meeting of prominent Guilford County citizens to discuss a plan to combat tuberculosis
- ♦ December 20, 1921 -- Citizens approved bond issue \$100,000 for building sanatorium; \$125,000 more provided by county and private donations
- ♦ January 22, 1924 -- Hospital officially opened with 46 beds. Dr. J. L. Spruill appointed superintendent
- ♦ 1926 -- Children's Building
- ♦ May 1, 1934 -- Dr. M. D. Bonner replaced Dr. Spruill as superintendent
- ♦ 1936 -- Sanatorium at maximum capacity, 142 beds
- ♦ December 24, 1955 -- Sanatorium closed; approximately forty patients moved to state sanatorium in Moore County
- ♦ 1958 -- Land and facilities of sanatorium allocated to Guilford Industrial Education Center by County Commissioners
